Adventurous hip-hop ensemble **Shabazz Palaces** and pop-punk sparkplugs **Tacocat** have little in common except a hometown, record labels (Sub Pop and its Hardly Art subsidiary, respectively), and a love of herb. Nevertheless, last October, **The Goodship**—a local cannabis edibles company—linked up the two acts and transported them to

a small fishing village on Southwest Washington's coast where they posted up in the **Tokeland Hotel** to record with producer and Stranger Genius **Erik Blood**.
